

Initial home assessment Information Sheet

Initial Visit and Completion of Occupational Therapy Recommendation

Responsibilities for assessment and report as follows:

Assessment to include:

- **Standard – based on 3 hours of professional time**
- Assessment/recommendation of basic equipment/minor adaptations including. items of equipment eg bathboard & seat, raised toilet seat and minor adaptations such as internal grab rails
- **Medium – based on max 5 hours of professional time**
- Multi Assessment/recommendation of equipment /minor/major adaptations to home including manual and powered equipment eg bathlift, bed lifter, rails internal/external
and/or
straightforward major adaptations including stairlifts, level access shower, ramps
- **Complex – based max 7 hours of professional time**
- Multi Assessment/recommendation of equipment /minor/major adaptations such as , powered equipment eg outdoor buggy, mobile hoist,and/or major adaptations such as ground/double floor extensions, through floor lifts etc
- Manual Handling
- Specialist Assessment including – paediatrics', wheelchairs,

Report to include:

- Identified problems/ needs/risks to service user
- Recommendations and clinical reasoning for best solution to `meet needs`, and what options not considered to be suitable
- Summary/outcome
- Details of equipment/adaptations i.e. make/model/cost/features/supplier etc.
